### PANTHERS LOOKING FOR WIN OVER SWAC RIVAL

The Prairie View A&M Panthers return home for the first time since Dec. 3 for an important SWAC match-up against longtime rival Texas Southern on Saturday night inside the Baby Dome. The Panthers enter Saturday's game looking for a much-needed win as their 0-2 in SWAC play after dropping games at Southern and Alcorn State this past weekend. After a tough non-conference slate which saw the Panthers play a rigorous, road heavy schedule, the second half of the season is two games in as the Panthers aspire to capture their first regular season title since the 2002-03 campaign.

### HONOR A FALLEN PANTHER

Head coach **Byron Rimm II** and the Prairie View A&M family lost a former Panther recently in former student-athlete **Mayol Riathin**. Riathin, who played for the Panthers from 2011-2013, died recently in a car accident which took place in the state of Wyoming. Riathin wore No. 33 during his tenure at PVAMU and the number will not be worn this season as it was originally assigned to **Nolan Wilson**.

### THE SERIES

Dating back to 1980, TSU holds a 57-19 mark against PVAMU with 17 of PVAMU's wins occurring in 1997 or later. PVAMU and TSU last met in March of 2014 in the finals of the SWAC Tournament as TSU prevailed 78-73 at the Toyota Center in Houston. PVAMU head coach **Byron Rimm II** is 7-13 lifetime versus Texas Southern and 1-4 when coaching against TSU's **Mike Davis** on the sidelines.

### ABOUT THE PANTHERS

Prairie View A&M returns four starters from last year's team which advanced to the finals of the SWAC Basketball Tournament for the second consecutive season. The Panthers also return a total of six letterwinners but lose a total of seven lettermen. Senior guard **Montrael Scott** received first team preseason honors as the Prairie View A&M men's basketball team was picked to finish sixth in the annual SWAC Men's Basketball Preseason poll.

Scott leads the team in scoring with 14.1 points per game while senior guard **John Brisco** ranks second in scoring with 12.4 points per game. Fellow senior guard **Tre Hagood** has upped his scoring output to 9.9 points per game while grabbing 5.1 rebounds and dishing out 4.7 assists. Junior post **Karim York** is the team's leading rebounder with 5.4 per game along with chipping in 9.9 points.

**WILLIAM NICKS PRESS ROW**

The William Nicks Building opens two hours prior to game time. The press row is located on the gym floor of the Williams Nicks Building and can accommodate television, print and radio personnel. Play-by-play game accounts will be distributed at the conclusion of each half while a full booklet containing play-by-play and stats provided after the game. **BYRON RIMM II**  
Head Coach

Byron Rimm II begins his ninth season as the head men's basketball coach at Prairie View A&M University. Rimm, who has a vast coaching background that spans from the junior college ranks to the NCAA Division I level, assumed the head coaching reigns at Prairie View after spending the 2005-06 campaign as the team's assistant coach.

Armed with the task of rebuilding a program that has had only two winning seasons since moving up to the NCAA Division I ranks in 1980, Rimm has slowly put his touch on the program in his first three seasons at the helm. In his first season after accepting the head job in 2006, Rimm guided the team to a three-game improvement in the win column and narrowly missed the SWAC Tournament as the Panthers fell short in the final week of the regular season. Individually, the SWAC also took notice and selected Brian Ezeh as the league's newcomer of the year. During the 2007-08 campaign, the Panthers began to make strides under Rimm as they made national headlines for their performance against nationally ranked Tennessee. In addition, the Panthers also captured their first NCAA Division I win since 2005 with a win over Norfolk State and defeated Jackson State on the road for the first time in two decades.

After two seasons of rebuilding, everything fell into place for Rimm during the 2008-09 campaign as the Panthers got over the hump and made a big splash as they finished with their best record and finish since 2002-03 with a 17-16 record and third-place finish. Led by SWAC Newcomer of the Year and All-SWAC First-Teamer Darnell Hugee, the Panthers advanced to the second round of the SWAC Basketball Tournament for only the third time since 1998 with an opening round win over Mississippi Valley State.

In 2009-10, Rimm continued to build on his previous accomplishments as he became the first head coach at Prairie View A&M since 2002 to make consecutive SWAC Tournament appearances. In addition, Rimm held a four-game winning streak over Texas Southern which marked the longest winning streak over the Tigers prior to 1980. As a result of the team's success, three Panthers also earned the opportunity to play professional basketball overseas in Darnell Hugee, Dorian McDaniel and point guard Chris Jones. Hugee inked with Saint Vallier Basketball Drome of France while McDaniel played in Germany with Duesseldorf. Jones ventured to Slovakia as he signed a contract with BC Prievizda.

During the 2010-11 campaign, Rimm earned the program's third SWAC Tournament appearance as the Panthers were the top-ranked offensive rebounding team in the SWAC. Two members (Trant Simpson and Brandon Webb) earned All-SWAC honors with Webb posting career highs in field goal percentage, points and rebounding.

Rimm had the task of meshing a roster which featured 10 newcomers entering the 2011-12 campaign. Despite the large amount of newcomers present, Rimm guided the Panthers to their best finish in three seasons and the program's fourth consecutive SWAC Tournament Appearance. Under Rimm, the Panthers were the SWAC's top rebounding team as they led the league in rebounding margin, rebounding offense, offensive rebounds and defensive rebounding. The Panthers also improved their offensive production last season as they finished second in scoring offense and third in scoring margin. Defensively, Prairie View A&M ranked second

in three-point field goal percentage defense and third in field goal percentage defense, steals and scoring margin.

Two seasons ago, the program turned a huge corner under Rimm as the Panthers advanced to the finals of the SWAC Tournament Championship for the first time since 1998 en route to falling in the closing seconds of the tournament. The Panthers also had a memorable season as they defeated a pair of teams from Conference USA and the Patriot League while also dominating the glass as they finished 17th nationally in total rebounds, 24th in three-point field goal defense and 47th in field goal percentage defense. Individually, senior guard Jourdan DeMuyneck earned Second Team All-SWAC honors for his play during the regular season while DeMuyneck and guard Carl Blair received All-Tournament honors. DeMuyneck also received an opportunity to play professionally as he inked with Keravnos Strovolou in the Republic of Cyprus.

Last season, the Panthers came within minutes of making history once again as they fell in the finals of the SWAC Tournament for the second straight season. Junior guard Montrael Scott had a career season as he emerged as a team leader while the Panthers were deadly from beyond the arc as they led the SWAC in three-pointers made.

In the classroom, Rimm also made news as the men's basketball program posted the top score amongst men's basketball teams in the SWAC during the annual Academic Progress Report (APR) released by the NCAA. The team posted its highest APR in program history with a score of 944. Only three basketball teams in the SWAC posted scores of 900 or higher with a 27-point difference separating the Panthers from the closest institution.

A native of Pensacola, Fla., Rimm played junior college ball on the West Coast at Ventura College in Ventura, Calif. He was team captain on the school's 1995-96 state championship team before wrapping up his playing career at California State University, Los Angeles. He remained on the West Coast and began his ascension up the coaching ladder by serving as an assistant coach at Pasadena City College and Chaffey Community College from 1997-2000. After several years on the junior college level, Rimm moved to California State University, San Bernardino in 2000 and helped guide the team to a No. 3 ranking in NCAA Division II. He spent only season at UCB before assuming the reigns as the head women's basketball coach at Texas College in Tyler, Texas.

Heading a program that didn't offer athletic scholarships, Rimm rolled up his sleeves and posted a 20-12 record in his inaugural season - the best record in school history. After one season at Texas College, Rimm returned to the men's side and accepted a position as head coach of Jarvis Christian College in nearby Hawkins, Texas.

While at Jarvis, Rimm made an immediate impact in his first season and guided the Bulldogs to a second place finish in the Red River Athletic Conference and their first NAIA National Tournament appearance in more than three decades. As a result of JCC's success on the court that season, Rimm was selected as co-coach of the year and had two players earn all-conference honors in addition to earning votes for the NAIA national poll.

Rimm capped off his career at JCC by leading them to two appearances in the Red River Athletic Conference Tournament and recorded victories over two nationally ranked programs before moving on to Prairie View A&M as an assistant coach for the 2005-06 campaign.

A 1999 graduate of California State University, Los Angeles, Rimm received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Liberal Studies and also obtained a master's degree in education from American InterContinental University in 2005. He also holds memberships in the National Association of Basketball Coaches and Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc.

Rimm is single and has one daughter, Jaya Nicole (7). He currently resides in Houston, Texas.

**LAST TIME THEY MET  
Texas Southern 78  
Prairie View A&M 73  
Sat., March 14, 2014**

Texas Southern went on a 13-2 run after the half en route a 78-73 win over Prairie View in the finals of the 2014 SWAC Tournament.

The Panthers (11-23), who were led by 19 points from junior guard **Montreal Scott**, rallied down the stretch.

**Demondre Chapman** drove to the basket and dunked to bring the Panthers within five at 70-65 with a couple of minutes to go.

**Aaric Murray's** block with 40 seconds to go sealed the victory. **Louis Munks** scored seven points to lead the Panthers to an 11-4 lead.

As the half went on, Munks' teammates joined in as Prairie View shot 55 percent from the field in the first half. Sharp shooting and five early turnovers from Texas Southern kept the Panthers in the lead.

The Tigers had a response, led by Murray.

Helping Murray was Gibbs, who sparked the Tigers early with assists and by driving to the hoop when the Tigers offense sputtered.

Munks and Murray traded field goals down the stretch and Prairie View led 38-31 at the half.

The Tigers hit four of their first five shots in a 13-2 run in the second half to take their first lead of the game when Murray hit two free throws for a lead the Tigers would never give up.

**THE LAST TIME**

Texas Southern has turned the tide of the series lately by winning eight-of-10 contests since March of 2010.

Prior to PVAMU's win in 2012, the four straight wins by TSU marked its longest streak in the series since winning 20 straight from 1987 to 1997.

**RIMM vs. TSU**

Saturday's game marks the 21st time head coach **Byron Rimm II** will face TSU.

As the head coach at PVAMU, Rimm has faced TSU 19 times and holds a 7-12 mark. His career mark against the Tigers is 7-13.

Before coming to PVAMU in 2005 as an assistant, Rimm faced TSU while serving as head coach at Jarvis Christian College and fell 81-68 on Dec. 8, 2004 in Houston.

**PROTECT YOUR TURF**

TSU has won five of the past nine games at Prairie View.

Prairie View A&M's home wins in 2009, 2010 and 2012 versus TSU in the Baby Dome marked the first time since 2003 that the Panthers defeated TSU at home. In 2004 and 2005, the series moved to Houston's Toyota Center before returning to both campuses in 2006.

In the H&PE Arena, TSU has dominated the series since the building opened. Since 1989, TSU sports a 19-4 record against PVAMU in the arena with PVAMU's last win occurring in 2010.



**FAMILY RIVALRY**

Located less than an hour apart, PVAMU and TSU have shared many things over the years from ideas, concepts and employees.

It all started in April of 2008 as Texas Southern made several administrative changes in athletics as they lured former PVAMU athletic director **Charles McClelland** to its campus in the same capacity.

Once McClelland got to TSU, several PVAMU staff members rejoined him at TSU including equipment manager **Ed-die Davis**, head baseball coach **Michael Robertson**, marketing director **Steffann Robinson** and SID **Andrew Roberts**. Eventually, PVAMU's public address announcer left while current head volleyball coach **Jocelyn Adams**, a PVAMU alumnus and former head volleyball coach at the school, left the high school ranks to rebuild the TSU program in 2011. In the spring of 2012, former PVAMU head women's basketball coach **Cynthia Cooper** returned to Houston and TSU after a stint at UNC-Wilmington.

Although Cooper spent one season at TSU before departing for USC, the ties are still strong as second-year TSU head women's coach **Johnetta Hayes-Perry** served as a graduate assistant at PVAMU for two seasons while assistant **Twila Stokes** was a four-year letterman. Recently, former PVAMU head football coach **Heishma Northern** accepted the defen-

sive coordinator position at TSU.

**CLOSE CALLS**

Outside of one game each in 2013, 2012, 2011, 2009, 2008 and both games in 2006, TSU and Prairie View has gone down to the wire in 26 of the past 42 meetings dating back to 1997.

In those 26 games, neither team has won by more than eight points. They've played in four overtime games over the past 14 seasons.

**ROAD WARRIORS**

In non-conference play, the Panthers have lived out their suitcases this fall as 12 of their 13 contests were away from campus. Prairie View A&M traveled to a total of four states (Hawai'i, Nevada, Oklahoma, Tennessee) and played in three different time zones (Central, Hawaii-Aleutian, Pacific).

The team's lone non-conference home game took place on Dec. 3 versus Schreiner.

**DEFEND THE 3**

The Panthers rank first in the SWAC in three-point field goal defense as their holding teams to 29.7 percent shooting.

### ROAD WOES

If the Panthers are ever to have success, winning on the road is a must as the Panthers are currently 1-13 in the 2014-15 campaign

Overall, the Panthers are shooting 38 percent and 30 percent from beyond the arc while on the road, they're shooting 38.5 percent from the field and 29.8 percent from the three-point line.

At home, the team is shooting 38.9 percent and 41 percent from the three-point line inside the friendly confines of the Baby Dome.

PVAMU is shooting 61.6 percent from the free throw line on the road and 65.4 percent at home.

### BRIS(K)O

Senior guard **John Brisco** is playing at a brisk pace with 12.4 points per game.

The Longview, Texas native stated out slow with a combined five points in his first two games before heating up with seven consecutive games in double digits, including a 20 and 24-point performance versus Rice and Stephen F. Austin.

Overall, Brisco has scored double digits in 10 of the past 12 contests.

### GREAT SCOTT

Senior guard **Montrael Scott** is coming off a career season and was rewarded for his efforts with a spot on the All-SWAC Preseason First Team.

The Dallas, Texas native was the SWAC's fourth-leading and team-leading scorer with 14.9 points per contest. He led the Panthers in scoring on 14 occasions last season and had seven games as the team's leading rebounder. Scott also led the Panthers in three-point shooting (41 percent) and was named SWAC Player of the Week twice, College Sports Madness Player of the Week once and also received SWAC All-Tournament Team honors.

Scott leads the team in scoring with 13.5 points per game.

### COUNTDOWN TO 1,000

Senior guard **Montrael Scott** is closing in on a historical landmark as he needs only 65 points for his 1,000th career point.

Scott, the team's leading scorer, has compiled 935 total points and is on pace to surpass the milestone in mid-to-late January.

### DIVERSITY

Head coach **Byron Rimm II** leaves no stone unturned in the recruiting process as four states are represented on this year's roster.

Rimm has 12 players from Texas and one player each from Arkansas, Florida and Illinois.

### NEW FACES

For the first time since the 2010-11 campaign, the Panthers will have a different look to their coaching staff with the addition of new assistant coaches **Ryan Price** and **Keenan Curry**.

Price, the son of current Lamar head coach **Tic Price**, comes to PVAMU from SWAC rival Southern University while Curry joins the Panthers after a stint at Emporia State.

### NOTHING IS FREE ABOUT THOSE

For the past four seasons, the Panthers have ranked amongst the nation's worst in free throw percentage. After three years of ranking next-to-last nationally in free throw percentage, PVAMU was ahead of the curve last year but reverted back to its old ways towards the end of the year as they finished ninth in the SWAC and 320th nationally with a 64.9 percent clip.

The Panthers currently rank eighth in the SWAC this season with a 150-for-241 clip (62%).



### ASSIST FACTOR

Senior point guard **Tre Hagood** will be counted on to make sure the PVAMU offensive machine runs at full strength. Hagood came on very strong during PVAMU's SWAC Tournament run and finished fifth in assists with 3.8 per game.

This season, Hagood has lived up to the hype as he averages 4.7 assists (3rd in SWAC) and ranks 13th in the SWAC with 5.1 rebounds per game.

### A NEW YORK

Junior post **Karim York** will play a vital role in the success of this year's team as he's averaging a career-high 9.9 points per game along with 5.4 rebounds.

The 6-9 junior from Austin is well ahead of last year's output as he only averaged 3.4 points and 1.6 rebounds last season.

### EXPERIENCE IS A MUST

Even though the Panthers feature 10 newcomers to the roster, six of them have prior collegiate experience either at the NCAA Division I, Division II or NAIA levels.

Seniors **John Brisco** (Northwestern State), **Tre Hagood** (Florida A&M) and junior **Karim York** (Santa Clara) originally began their careers at Division I programs while senior post **Reggis Onwukamuche** began his collegiate career at Wiley College (NAIA).

### SWITCHING GEARS

The non-conference slate hasn't been kind to Prairie View A&M head coach **Byron Rimm II** since he took over the reigns at Prairie View A&M in 2006.

In eight years, Rimm is 31-85 in non-conference matchups with his only NCAA Division I wins coming against Bethune-Cookman, Houston, Navy, Norfolk State, North Texas, Florida Gulf Coast and Stephen F. Austin.

In SWAC play, Rimm holds a career mark of 66-80.

Four TCU players scored in double-figures to lead the Horned Frogs to a 71-54 win over Prairie View A&M in the season-opener for both teams.

TCU was playing its first game at Wilkerson-Greines Activity Center, its home for the 2014-15 season while the on-campus Daniel-Meyer Coliseum undergoes renovations.

Trey Zeigler, who sat out last season after transferring from Pittsburgh, scored 14 points. Karviar Shepherd added 13 to go with rebounds for the Horned Frogs.

Prairie View A&M's Jacoby Green cut the deficit to 38-34 on a three-pointer with 14:49 remaining, but TCU responded with a 22-4 run. Tre Hagood ended the run with a pair of free-throws and consecutive three-pointers over a 47-second span, snapping a 9:37 field goal drought for the Panthers.

TCU was able to utilize its size throughout the game, outscoring Prairie View A&M 38-16 in the paint as well as holding a 50-25 rebounding advantage. The Horned Frogs did victimize themselves, however, with 16 turnovers.

The Panthers were one game away from clinching the SWAC's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament each of the last two years. Hagood and Karim York led the squad with 13 points apiece.

Phil Forte scored 17 points, and Le'Bryan Nash had 15 points and seven rebounds, to lead Oklahoma State to a 74-52 victory over Prairie View A&M Sunday afternoon at Gallagher-Iba Arena.

The Cowboys (2-0) led 31-25 at the break but broke open the game by rolling out to a 20-4 run over the first 8-plus minutes of the second half. Jeffrey Carroll added 12 points and four rebounds for OSU, while Anthony Allen contributed six points and a career-high 14 rebounds.

Montrael Scott scored 16 points and added four rebounds to lead Prairie View A&M (0-2), while Tre Hagood had 12 points and 12 rebounds.

Leading 31-25 at halftime, the Cowboys quickly extended their advantage to 13 points after Nash hit a free throw and Carroll connected on back-to-back 3-pointers just over 2 minutes in.

Nash then scored the next six points for Oklahoma State to make it 44-29 with 15:19 remaining, and when Forte sank a 3-pointer from the right side with 11:48 to go, the Cowboys held a commanding 22-point lead.

It was the second straight game that OSU carried a small lead into halftime before taking over and pulling away in the second half. The Cowboys led 35-33 at the break in their first contest against Southeastern Louisiana before winning the second half 48-22 en route to an 83-55 triumph.

Oklahoma State gained some momentum early after senior guard Marek Soucek was leveled with an errant hand to the face by Prairie View's Delvon Rencher away from the play with 10:33 left in the first half. Soucek went down hard and stayed there for several moments, clearly shaken up.

With the score tied 10-10, Rencher was called for a flagrant foul, and Forte stepped in to sink both free throws, starting an 8-0 Cowboys run over the next 2 minutes. Soucek never returned.

The Panthers responded with a 6-1 run of their own to pull back to within 19-16, but Oklahoma State continued to build on its lead after that and never led by fewer than four points after that.
