THIS WEEK'S GAME

The Prairie View A&M Panthers return to the state of Louisiana for the second time this year as they're set to battle Jackson State in the second annual Shreveport Classic on Saturday, Oct. 29 at Independence Stadium. This marks the second of a four-game agreement Prairie View A&M has with the city of Shreveport. Next year, the Panthers are slated to battle Southern in the third edition of the Shreveport Classic.

After a stumble at Alabama State on Oct. 15, the Panthers are a half-game ahead of Arkansas-Pine Bluff in the SWAC West race and are rounding towards the finish line with only three conference games left. PV still controls its own destiny up to this point but will need to continue to win in order solidify a championship game berth.

Despite being ineligible for the SWAC Championship Game due to APR sanctions, Jackson State is playing

solid football as they're in second place in the SWAC East with its lone loss to Alabama State. JSU is ranked 19th nationally in the Football Championship Subdivision Poll and was picked to win the SWAC East during the annual SWAC Pre-season poll.

Saturday's contest will be televised live by SWAC-TV which can be accessed via www.SWAC.org.

ABOUT THE PANTHERS

Prairie View A&M was picked to finish third in the 2011 SWAC Preseason poll as they begin the year under new head coach **Heishma Northern**.

A total of eight starters (4 O/4 D) return as the Panthers begin their first year under a new coach since 2004. Senior cornerback **Moses Ellis** is the defensive leader after leading the nation in interceptions (8) during the 2010 season. The Panthers also return a pair of senior defensive linemen in **Adrian Hamilton, Jarvis Wilson**

and a pair of young linebackers in **Marcus White** and **Raheem Cardwell**.

Offensively, new offensive coordinator **Mark Orlando** inherits a young offense that returns four starters. The Panthers have to replace several All-SWAC standouts at the quarterback, running and wide receiver position. The offensive line is the most experienced unit with three starters back.

On special teams, the Panthers also have to rebuild with only one player back (**Spencer Nelson**) with significant experience.

From a coaching perspective, this year marks the first major overhaul of the coaching staff at Prairie View A&M since 2005 as four coaches join the staff.

LAST GAME RESULT: ASU 20, PV 7 - OCT. 20, 2011

MONTGOMERY, Ala. - **Nick Andrews** caught a 34-yard touchdown pass and became Alabama State's career receptions leader as the Hornets remained unbeaten in Southwestern Athletic Conference play by beating Prairie View A&M 20-7 on Saturday.

Andrews caught nine passes for 118 yards, giving him 178 for his career with the Hornets (6-1, 6-0), two more than **Damon Hodge**.

Alabama State took advantage of a fumble by the Panthers (4-3, 4-2) to open the scoring on **Greg Jenkins'** 10-yard touchdown

run 1:35 into the game. Jenkins' scoring pass to Andrews made it 14-0 in the second quarter.

Jenkins completed 21 of 31 for 215 yards with an interception.

The Hornets defense also came up big, stopping the Panthers twice from the 1-yard line in the second quarter, and **Kejuan Riley** made his sixth interception of the season in the fourth quarter.

Fred Anderson rushed for 101 yards on 20 carries for the Panthers.

ABOUT THE JSU TIGERS

Jackson State features a high-powered offensive unit and has ascended up the polls to No. 19 amongst the FCS ranks.

Led by veteran coach **Rick Comegy**, JSU is in second place in the SWAC East and features quarterback **Casey Therriault**, the SWAC's Preseason Player of the Year and passing leader.

A balanced team, JSU leads the SWAC in total offense and ranks second in total defense, led by **Joseph Lebeau's** 52 tackles and 10 sacks.

Due to the SWAC schedule undergoing a change over the past few years, this year's game marks only the second time since 2007 that PV and JSU has met in consecutive seasons.

Casey Therriault threw for 291 yards and a touchdown as Jackson State beat Prairie View A&M 30-13 in a Southwestern Athletic Conference game Saturday night.

Therriault, who leads Football Championship Subdivision passers with 335 yards per game, gave the Tigers (6-2, 4-2) a 7-0 lead with a 10-yard pass to **Marcellos Wilder**. He completed 27 of 39.

With Jackson State leading 14-3 at halftime, **Kyle Mathews** kicked his second field goal for the Panthers (5-4, 4-3), a 25-yarder, after **Michael Benson** returned the second-half kickoff 63 yards.

A Tigers safety made it 16-6 when Milton Patterson stopped **Donald Babers** in the end zone.

After Jackson State broke it open with 1-yard scoring runs in the fourth quarter by Therriault and B.J. Lee to lead 30-6, the Panthers got their only touchdown when **Quinton Spears** blocked a punt and **Adrian Hamilton** recovered it for the score.

THE LAST TIME

Prairie View has turned the tide of the series against JSU as they've won two of the past four meetings against Jackson State. Since the SWAC went to divisional play and instituted seven-game mandates on several occasions since 1999, both teams have only met seven times since 1999.

JSU has dominated the series by virtue of a 28-game winning streak from 1973 to 2004.

BEEN HERE BEFORE

This isn't Prairie View's first rodeo in the city of Shreveport as this marks the third contest in the city since 2003.

The Panthers played Southern in 2003 here in Shreveport before the start of the annual Shreveport Classic in 2010.

NORTHERN AND SHREVEPORT

Head coach **Heishma Northern** has been pretty successful as a player and a coach when in Shreveport.

As a player in 1992 at Southern, Northern was on a team that defeated Winston-Salem State at Independence Stadium. He returned to the stadium as a coach at Grambling State in 1998 and fell to Arkansas-Pine Bluff. However, Northern hasn't lost in the "Port City" since 1998 as he's 6-1 overall as an assistant coach.

WIN, WIN & WIN

Once known for its infamous 80-game losing streak, times have changed as the past three years have been great for Prairie View A&M football.

Since the final game of the 2006 campaign, Prairie View has won 37 of its past 48 contests.

MOMENTUM

Senior cornerback **Moses Ellis** has emerged as one of the top cornerbacks in the SWAC and on the FCS level.

The senior from Fort Worth, Texas led the FCS ranks with eight interceptions. Ellis has a larger role this fall as he also returns punts. After not having an interception in five games this year, Ellis finally broke through with an interception for a touchdown against Southern on Oct. 8.

REUNION TIME

Jackson State's **Rick Comegy** will see a familiar face on the Prairie View A&M sideline in wide receivers coach **Harry Williams**.

Williams played under Comegy at Tuskegee for four seasons and was a standout wide receiver and kick returner. He was drafted by the New York Jets in the seventh round of the 2005 NFL Draft.

BACK IN THE SWAC

Offensive coordinator **Mark Orlando** is a seasoned veteran with over 30 years of experience who has had success at most of his stops.

He helped win the first Division I-AA Championship as an assistant at Florida A&M in the late 1970s and made his name in the SWAC as Southern won the 1993 SWAC Championship in his first year. Orlando won a share of the MEAC Championship in 2010 during his first season at Bethune-Cookman and hopes to do the

same at PV in 2011.

Against Jackson State, Orlando has had some memorable moments while the offensive coordinator at Southern. When coordinating against JSU, Orlando holds a 7-8 mark with two games as the offensive coordinator at Texas Southern in 2002 and 2003.

REUNION TIME

Saturday's contest in Shreveport will feature an assortment of storylines headlined by PV head coach **Heishma Northern** returning to his home state.

A 1996 mathematics education graduate of Southern University, Northern is a Baton Rouge native and former player at Southern under **Marino Casem** and **Pete Richardson**.

Northern's college teammate, defensive backs coach **Raasaan Haralson**, played defensive back at Southern and won a pair of Heritage Bowls in 1993 and 1995. A Baton Rouge native, Haralson also coached at LSU and Tennessee.

Also returning to Louisiana is defensive line and special teams assistant **Gabe Northern**, Heishma's younger brother. Gabe attended LSU and had a standout football career there before playing several years in the NFL in addition to coaching in West Monroe, La.

SACK MASTER

Prairie View A&M senior defensive end **Adrian Hamilton** is tearing the SWAC up this year with a total of 12.5 sacks so far.

He had a career game against UAPB on Sept. 17 with a career-high four sacks and 10 tackles. He followed it up on Sept. 24 versus Mississippi Valley State with three more sacks and nine tackles. Hamilton had 10 tackles and a sack versus Grambling and two more sacks against Southern last weekend.

The Dallas native has 12.5 sacks on the season, 59 tackles and

19.5 tackles for loss. As a result, he has now emerged as a Buck Buchanan Award Nominee which is awarded to the top defensive player on the FCS level. He's also a FCS Defensive Player of the Week (Oct. 10) and a three-time SWAC Player of the Week.

NAME TAGS PLEASE

The Panthers have plenty of new faces on both sides of the ball making contributions this season. That's a far cry from the past as freshmen usually redshirted at Prairie View but depth issues forced a change in philosophy this year.

Offensively, several freshmen play see action at wide receiver, quarterback and running back.

GET USED TO IT

Head coach **Heishma Northern** stated before the season that the Panthers would play two or three quarterbacks at times until they settle on a starter.

The Panthers began the year with senior **Jonathan Troast** as the starter but turned to redshirt freshman **Jerry Lovelocke** in week two. Lovelocke took over the reigns up until Oct. 8 as an injury against Grambling coupled with a solid second-half performance allowed Troast to take the controls against Southern.

However, true freshman **De'Auntre Smiley** has also emerged as he played the entire second half against Alabama State on Oct. 15 in relief of Troast and led PV on a touchdown drive.

SPECIAL TEAMS, SPECIAL RESULTS

Prairie View's special teams have been big to open the season. Coached by **Brian Morgan** and **Gabe Northern**, the units blocked both a PAT and field goal while also returning a field goal for a long gain plus a kickoff

return for a touchdown by senior **Jermaine Waddy** versus Texas Southern.

Against Arkansas-Pine Bluff, the unit helped UAPB commit three safeties during punt situations along with blocking a punt. Freshman punter **Travis Jatzlau** also had a strong game with a 73-yard punt.

In the kicking game, red-shirt freshman **Chris Barrick** has nailed 7-of-11 field goals with a long of 46 yards. He has also kicked game-winning field goals against TSU and Southern.

OUTSIDE HELP

As PV breaks in a new quarterback, they'll need a lot of help from its wide receivers in the team's new offense.

Fortunately, that help is slowly emerging as redshirt junior wideout **Spencer Nelson** has caught 34 passes for 418 yards and three scores followed by freshman **Greg Thurmond** with 15 receptions for 266 yards and three touchdowns. Running backs **Jermaine Waddy** and **Fred Anderson** have also helped with a combined 27 receptions.

TURNOVERS PLEASE?

Turnovers have been hard to come by for the Panthers this season with a total of five during their first seven games. The first turnover occurred on Sept. 24 as junior defensive lineman **Donald Law** picked up a fumble and returned it 32 yards to set up a touchdown run.

The second took place on Oct. 1 in Dallas as freshman **Tobias Milton** intercepted a pass. **Moses Ellis** recorded the third on Oct. 8 as he picked off an interception for a touchdown followed by a late fumble which was recovered by **JohnMark Henderson**.

HAPPY RETURN

The Panthers have been banged up this fall as several players missed games due to pre-season injuries.

One of those players who took full advantage of his time out was redshirt sophomore linebacker **Marcus White**. White recorded 16 tackles and 4.5 tackles for loss in his first game back against Mississippi Valley on Sept. 24.

For the season, White has 41 tackles, 9.5 tackles for loss, two sacks and a fumble recovery.

ROAD WARRIORS

The Panthers will live out of their suitcases this season with only three home games on campus. The month of October and early November will be the hardest stretch for the team as every game is on the road from Oct. 1 to Nov. 12.

PANTHERS ON THE TUBE

This fall, two Panther football games were available nationally on either ESPN or ESPNU. Recently picked up by Comcast Corporation along with its broadband partner ESPN360.com, ESPNU will have more than 46 million subscribers and ESPN360.com will be available to nearly 41 million homes, a majority of broadband homes in America.

Prairie View's first televised contest took place this weekend versus Bethune-Cookman while the second occurred on Oct. 15 at Alabama State.

The Panthers are fond of televised appearances with a record of 7-2 over the past three seasons on the ESPN family of networks.

PV FIRST-YEAR COACHES' HISTORY

Since records were recorded in 1923, only seven of the 25 head coaches have recorded winning seasons in their first season at Prairie View A&M.

The last coach to record a winning record in his inaugural season was **Hoover Wright** in 1966 (5-3-1). A pair of coaches had impressive first years as both **Sam B. Taylor** (1930) and **Jimmy Stevens** (1949) finished with 8-3 records.

FROM EQUIPMENT MANAGER TO STAR

This year marks a special time for wide receiver **Deandre Cooper** as football was the last thing on his mind several years ago.

Cooper suffered a tragic neck injury during a practice session as a true freshman in 2008 and missed both the 2008 and 2009 seasons.

After spending the 2009 season as an equipment manager, Cooper received medical clearance in 2010 to return to the field and spent last season playing special teams primarily.

Cooper was moved to wide receiver in the spring and instantly shined with two touchdowns in the spring game and is slated to play a large role in the offense this year.

He has caught 19 receptions on the season with two of them for touchdowns.

RECORD BREAKERS

Very few teams in the SWAC have as many record breakers on its coaching staff as Prairie View A&M.

Running backs coach **Brian Morgan** name is etched in the SWAC and national record-books as he's the all-time leading scorer amongst SWAC kickers and the career record holder with 50 field goals and single season field goal leader with 18. He also led Division I-AA following the 2001 campaign with 18 field goals and finished as the I-AA all-time leader with 197 extra points.

Graduate assistant **Clyde Edwards** was one of the most productive wide receivers in Grambling State history as he holds the school record for career touchdown receptions, receiving yards and the school single season record for touchdown receptions.

Graduate assistants **K.J. Black** and **Brady Faggard** helped rewrite PV's recordbooks as Faggard holds the school record for field goals made with 19 during his four-year career and also holds the school single-season record with 35 extra points made in 2009.

Black led PV to its first SWAC Championship in 2009 and broke six school passing records in only two years.

UP NEXT

A veteran of calling the action for more than 20 years, Moon also handles men's and women's basketball broadcasts on the Prairie View A&M Panther Sports Radio Network. He has been at the microphone for several history-making events most notably Prairie View's 2009 SWAC Football Championship, four straight winning football seasons and the Prairie View A&M Lady Panthers' three-straight SWAC Championships and three NCAA and NIT Tournament appearances.

HEAD FOOTBALL COACH HEISHMA NORTHERN

Heishma Northern was named the 31st head coach in university history on Dec. 13, 2010. No stranger to the Southwestern Athletic Conference, Northern begins his 15th season on the collegiate level and seventh season at Prairie View A&M.

Prior to becoming head coach, Northern was an award-winning defensive coordinator for six seasons at Prairie View A&M. Under his watch, the Panther defense has risen to become one of the top units in the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Ranks. For the fourth straight season, Northern's defense produced another All-American following the 2010 campaign as cornerback Moses Ellis led the nation in interceptions with eight and defended 22 passes en route to earning All-American and All-SWAC honors. As a unit, the Panthers finished second in pass defense amongst SWAC foes as they only yielded 164.6 yards per contest. As a result, four members of the Panther defense earned All-SWAC honors in Ellis (first team), defensive lineman Quinton Spears (first), free safety Chris Adingupu (second) and middle linebacker Max Sencherey (second).

Despite losing six key starters and a two-time All-American from the previous year, Prairie View's defensive unit was instrumental during the team's historic run to the SWAC Championship last year as the unit led the SWAC in scoring defense with 16.6 points per outing and pass defense efficiency (101.7). The Panthers finished the 2009 season ranked fifth in total defense and produced its second consecutive All-American in defensive back Anthony Beck along with having three All-SWAC members in Beck, Spears and Adingupu. In addition, Northern's unit recorded two shutouts on the season and held four teams to 74 yards or less on the ground.

In 2008, the Panther defense set the tone for the team's 9-1 record as they concluded the year ranked second nationally in scoring defense, third in total defense, third in rush defense and seventh in pass efficiency defense. Prairie View also made history and recorded two shutouts for the first time since the 1966 season.

As a result of Prairie View's defensive prowess, Northern earned national acclaim and was selected as Football-Scoop.com's 2008 Division I-AA Coordinator of the Year. Individually, linebacker Zach East closed out his career as a two-time All-American while Beck and Spears earned First and Second Team All-SWAC Honors, respectively.

During the 2007 season, Northern's defense played a key role in helping the Panthers clinch their first winning season in four decades as they finished atop the SWAC in scoring and red zone defense along with a third-place total defense ranking. A total of three starters earned All-SWAC honors led by East earning All-American and SWAC Defensive Player of the Year Honors.

One year removed from finishing sixth in total defense among SWAC foes, Northern made his mark in his second year at Prairie View during the 2006 season after fielding the top-ranked defensive unit in the conference. Led by first team All-SWAC defensive end and future NFL free agent signee Jermaine McGhee, the Panthers set a school record for fewest yards rushing by an opponent after holding Edward Waters College to -35 yards. For his hard work on the gridiron after the season, Northern was one of 26 coaches from across the nation invited to attend the NCAA Expert Coaches Academy in Miami, Fla.

Prior to his tenure at Prairie View, Northern spent seven seasons at Grambling State University in a variety of capacities.

Initially brought to GSU to serve as running backs coach, Northern made a seamless transition to coaching defensive backs in 2001 as his unit ranked ninth nationally in interceptions en route to GSU's second-straight SWAC Championship. During the 2002 season, which marked Grambling's third consecutive SWAC title, Northern's group improved on the interception mark as they ranked fourth nationally.

In 2003, Northern assumed the role of interim defensive coordinator and immediately made his impact felt as the Tiger defense finished the year ranked third nationally against the run in Division I-AA. In the SWAC, the Tigers finished second in rushing, third in scoring defense, fourth in opponent third down percentage, fourth in turnover margin and fifth in sacks.

Over the course of his coaching career, Northern has had several of his former players enter the professional football realm gaining experience with the NFL, World and Arena Football Leagues. In addition, several of his pupils have received an opportunity to coach on the collegiate level.

A 1996 mathematics education graduate of Southern University, Northern began his coaching career on the high school level at Glen Oaks High School in Baton Rouge, La. where he coached girl's basketball and baseball. He then moved on to Morehouse College in Atlanta, Ga. serving as the team's running backs coach and special teams coordinator in 1997 under former head coach, Super Bowl MVP and current Grambling State head coach Doug Williams.

A student of the game of football, Northern was one of only 15 coaches from across the nation selected to participate in the prestigious NCAA Champions Forum during June of 2010. He has also completed a training camp internship with the Oakland Raiders of the National Football League in the summer of 2009.

Northern, who also holds a master's degree in Sports Administration from Grambling State, is the oldest of three siblings and is married to the former Paula Duell of Baton Rouge, La. Together, they have two children, Adam (3) and newborn Brook.
